

Mireog is an Irish word meaning 'to frolick' or 'fit of flightiness'.

Based in the Deise Gaeltacht in County Waterford, Mireog was setup by Ilustrator/author Shona Shirley Macdonald and artist/educator Ciarán Ó Nualláin. We aim to promote Irish and other Celtic languages by creating playful and beautiful designs that are inspired by language, folklore and our natural world.

The environment is hugely important to us and this is why we print our cards in Ireland onto 100% recycled paper, and package our products without plastic. The cello bags are biodegradable, as they are made from annually renewable corn starch.

Shona is also a book illustrator and author, titles include "Cluasa Capaill ar an Rí' (Bridget Bhreathnach, Futa Fata), An Féileacán agus an Rí' (Máire Zepf, Futa Fata), 'The Pooka Party' (The O'Brien Press), 'The Moon Spun Round, W. B Yeats for Children' (Noreen Doody, The O'Brien Press).
